# Inclusion criteria for Homeopathic treatment in Oncology

# LUNG CA-

- 1. Primary lung cancer in cases with other co- morbidities making the patient not fit for chemo radiation.
- 2. Metastatic cases of lung CA in aged patients where chemo radiation have less chances.
- 3. In Lung CA after chemo radiation where reduction is not complete.

# LIVER CA-

- 1. Primary liver CA where TACE or RFA chances are less.
- 2. Metastatic CA where multiple liver lesions are there along with other secondaries.
- 3. To control AFP.

## PANCREAS CA-

- 1. In cases after whipples procedure.
- 2. In cases with upsurge of CA-19.9.
- 3. In cases where surgery/ Chemo radiation is not possible.

### **BREAST CA-**

- 1. Only in cases where chemo radiation/ Surgery is not possible.
- 2. Metastatic cases of CA breast especially with brain and bone secondaries to address sufferings .
- 3. After MRM with Axillary clearance in cases , to avoid adjuvant chemo radiation.

# **PROSTATE CA-**

- 1. In cases where skeletal metastasis in aged cases.
- 2. After TURPT to avoid Metastasis to bones.
- 3. Metastatic cases where chemo radiation is not possible.
- 4. To control PSA.

# **RECTAL CA-**

- 1. In cases where colostomy is not possible .
- 2. In cases where adjuvant chemo radiation fails to reduce morbidities.
- 3. In primary cases in aged patilents only.
- 4. In Metastatic cases to reduce metastatic foci after chemo radiation(liver/peritoneum).

## STOMACH CA-

- 1. In cases of linitis plastica where surgery is not feasible.
- 2. In cases where chemo radiation is not possible due to anemia and emaciation.
- 3. After partial or complete gastrectomy to deal with metastasis to liver.
- 4. To regain physiolgial equillibrium in case under Feeding jejunostomy(FJ).

## **ESOPHAGUS CA-**

- 1. Only in cases where surgery/ chemo/ radiation is contra indicated.
- 2. After chemo radiation or surgery to regain vitality.

# **CERVICAL CA-**

- 1. In cases where surgery or radiation is not possible.
- 2. After chemo radiation to deal with metastasis.
- 3. After hysterectomy to avoid metastasis in aged cases.

### ORAL CA-

1. Only in cases where medical condition contra indicative of conventional interventions.

# LYMPHOMA-

- 1. In cases where chemotherapy is not possible.
- 2. In case of aged and multiple lymphadenopathy after relapse of scheduled dosage of chemotherapy.
